

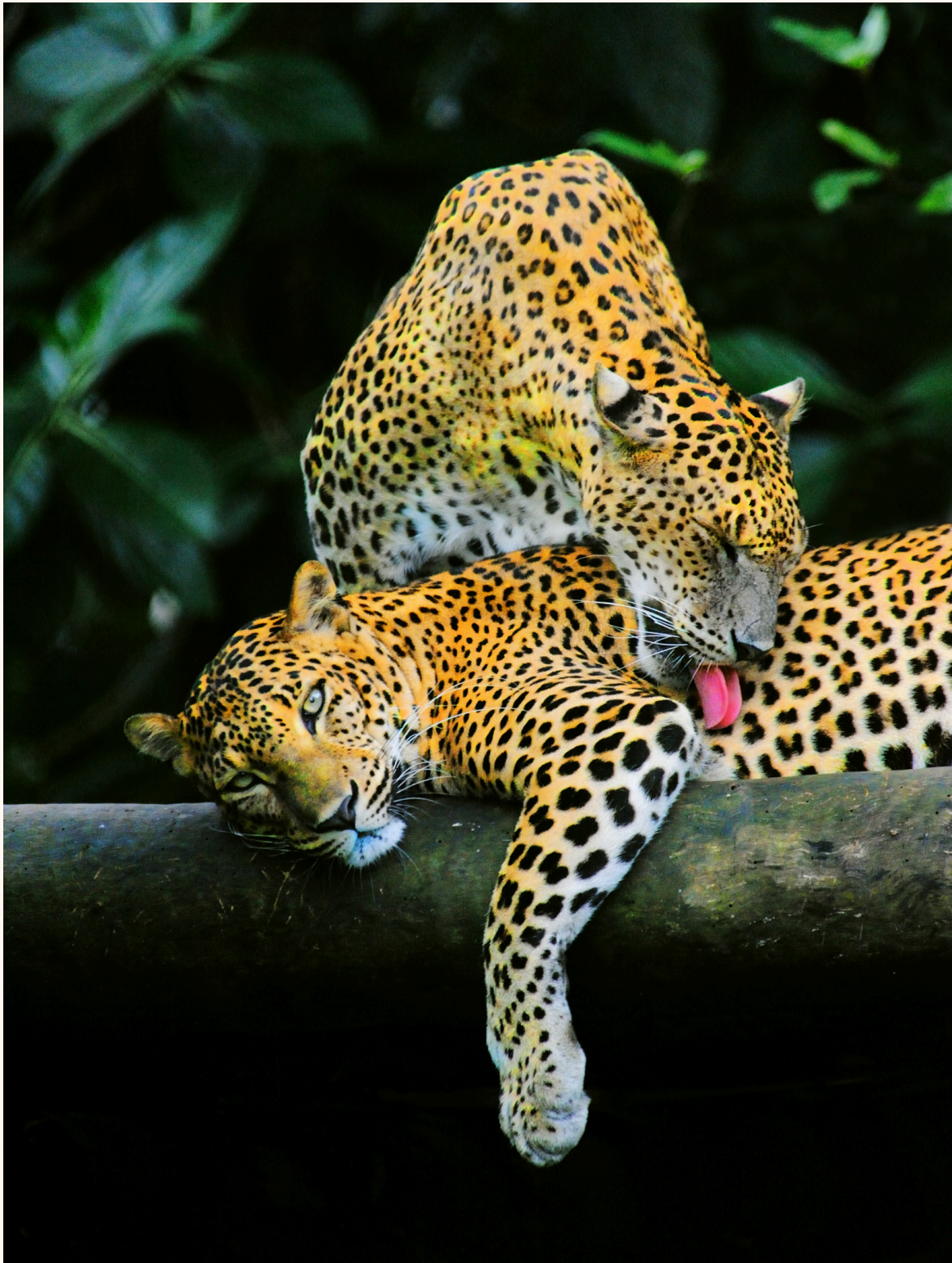

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## **Day 1**

### **Arrival - Colombo**

Meet and assist on arrival at Bandaranaike International Airport and transfer to your

Negombo Jetwing Lagoon Wellness 5\* or similar (Breakfast)

## **Day 2**

### **Negombo to Sigiriya (149 Kms/3.5 Hrs)**

A late breakfast followed by a 1 hour treatment at the spa to unwind and prepare you for your holiday. A drive through rural countryside will take you to your hotel where you will be spending the next 3 days.

## **Day 3**

### **Sigiriya**

Early morning, 06:00 climb the majestic Sigiriya Rock Fortress, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and explore its ancient frescoes, landscaped gardens, and breathtaking views from the summit. Afterwards, enjoy an authentic Hiriwaduna village trek where you will experience traditional Sri Lankan rural life, including a bullock cart ride, a boat crossing, and a local meal. Return to the hotel and spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure.

## **Day 4**

### **Sigiriya**

Morning, after breakfast explore the ancient kingdom of Polonnaruwa (1 hour drive), Sri Lanka's best preserved medieval city. For lunch, savor an unforgettable lunch at Ekho House, Polonnaruwa, with dishes that capture the rich, aromatic essence of Ceylon. A safari at Minneriya National Park, home to Sri Lanka's largest gathering of Elephants.

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## **Day 5**

### **Sigiriya to Kandy (73 Kms/2.15Hrs)**

A relaxed breakfast before you journey to Kandy. En route, visit the Dambulla Cave Temple famed for its rock paintings and Buddha statues. Along the way, stop at a Spice Garden to learn about the healing power of cinnamon, cardamom & turmeric – nature's own chest before

continuing onto Kandy. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel.

## **Day 6**

### **Kandy**

Morning, enjoy a stroll through the Peradeniya Botanical Gardens, home to a rich collection of flora. In the evening, visit the Temple of the Tooth in Kandy, beautifully lit and vibrant during evening rituals.

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### **Day 7**

#### **Kandy to Nuwara Eliya (74 Kms/2.5 Hrs)**

Morning, embark on a scenic drive to the cool hill town of Nuwara Eliya, also known as 'Little England' for its colonial charm, misty landscapes, and neatly manicured gardens. Enjoy a visit to a tea factory.

### **Day 8**

#### **Nuwara Eliya**

Rise early and depart on a 1-hour drive for an invigorating trek through the mist-shrouded hills of Horton Plains National Park, home to rare wildlife, cloud forests, and the breathtaking World's End cliff—a dramatic drop offering panoramic views that stretch for miles. After the adventure, return to your hotel and unwind soaking in the serenity of the highlands with a cup of tea at leisure.

### **Day 9**

#### **Nuwara Eliya to Ella (57 Kms/2 Hrs)– Train (80 Km/3hrs)**

Morning, after breakfast drive to the train station in Nanu-Oya where you will board your train to Ella. Make sure you sit on the righthand side of the carriage for the best views (3 hours). In Ella, spend some time exploring the town, with its many charming cafés and laid-back atmosphere.

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## **Day 10**

### **Ella**

Climb Little Adam's Peak for stunning panoramic views, enjoy a scenic trek through tea plantations, and visit the iconic Nine Arch Bridge, an architectural marvel surrounded by greenery. Rest of the day at leisure.

## **Day 11**

### **Ella to Yala (60Kms/1.5Hrs)**

Morning: Drive down to the southern coast with a scenic en-route stop at the stunning Ella Falls, where you can admire the cascading waters and take memorable photos. Continue to Yala National Park and check into Cinnamon Wild. After lunch, spend the rest of the day taking in the amazing sounds of nature outside your room.

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## **Day 12**

### **Yala**

Morning and Afternoon: Enjoy thrilling safaris at Yala National Park, Sri Lanka's most famous wildlife reserve. Renowned for its leopard population, the park is also home to elephants, bears, crocodiles, and a rich variety of birds, set against a backdrop of forests, lakes, and plains.

## **Day 13**

### **Yala to Galle (166 Kms/2.5Hrs)**

Journey from the jungles of Yala to the sun-drenched southern coast of Galle. The landscape gradually transforms, revealing sweeping vistas of the Indian Ocean.

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## **Day 14**

### **Galle**

This morning, explore the amazing Galle Fort, steeped in history with its cobbled streets and cafes before you check-in to your hotel. Today, relax by the beach or soak in the tropical sun.

Transfer to the airport, carrying unforgettable memories of an extraordinary holiday.
